Please be aware the booth map is subject to change. The renovations on Nathan Phillips Square are beyond the control of the TOAE organizers and may result in changes to assigned display areas.

Color Coded Sections

Nathan Phillips Square is divided into 7 color-coded sections.

- Yellow
- Turquoise
- Orange
- White
- Green
- Blue North/ Student Area
- Purple/ Student Area

Full Time Artists

Yellow, Turquoise, Orange, White, Green, Blue North #800 only

Display Area Size

Artists can choose a 10' x 10' area that can house a tent or a 15' x 5' area not tented.

Areas under overhangs cannot be tented.

15 x 5 Display Areas

There are five 15' x 5' areas available in Orange.

There corresponding numbers are: Orange 436, 437, 438, 439, 440

Turquoise has 2 areas 15' x 5'

There corresponding numbers are: Turquoise 506 & 507

No tents under overhangs

Overhang areas, from the upper walkways, cannot have tents under them.

Overhang areas:

Orange 424 through 435

White 25 through 29

White 41 through 50

All remaining areas can be tented

Students Display Areas

Blue North and Purple

5' x 15' areas not tented

- **Blue North** has 17 display areas numbered 803 through 819
Each area is 5' x 15' and can not be tented.
- **Purple** has 1- 5' x 15' area numbered 710

Purple 10 x 10 none-tented areas

Remaining purple areas are 10' x 10'.

Numbers 705, 706, 707, 708, 709, 711 are under overhang areas and cannot be tented

Purple 10 x 10 tented areas

712 through 718 can be tented.

725 through 740 can be tented.

Exhibition Guidelines and Liability

You are responsible for bringing or renting you own chairs, tables, display equipment, hanging supplies etc.

Knockdown display systems are required. Displays requiring construction of solid walls are not permitted. Shelves or display units must be secured and may be reviewed by TOAE and/or City Property Staff. For safety of exhibitors and visitors all display systems must be secured with weights or water ballasts.
